Handheld showers for these applications should be lightweight, hard wearing, easily held in soapy hands and feature a soft spray pattern that will not irritate sensitive skin. Hoses should also feature a smooth, non-abrasive surface to allow thorough cleaning. Con-Serv's handheld showers and hoses meet these requirements.

All Con-Serv handheld showers are fitted with licenced dual check/ non-return valves and are WELS 3-Star 9L/min or 4-Star 6.5L/min.


